Step 1



Wash the embroidered work. Put it with front side on a soft lining, smooth it out and iron till it is fully dry.



Cut off extra fabric pieces around the embroidery, leaving some outsizes, as shown on the photo (from the lateral sides around 0.5-0.7 cm, from below – 1 cm, from above – 1.5 cm).

For the back side of the flag the canvas or one-colour cotton fabric, linen can be used.



Put the embroidery (with front side inward) and back fabric together, equal the cutting edges.

Stitch along the upper edge of the embroidery, putting the bar tacks in the beginning and in the end of the stitch.

Step 3



Iron out the stitch. You may use a glue blister or textile glue to fix the upper outsizes. It would simplify running the cord through the ready-made flag.

Step 4



Again, put together the embroidery with the back fabric along the upper stitch, equal the cutting edges. Stitch the lateral sides leaving 0.7-1 cm from the upper stitch.



You may fix a small area of the lateral cutting edges in the upper part of the embroidery with a glue blister. It would simplify running the cord through the ready-made flag.

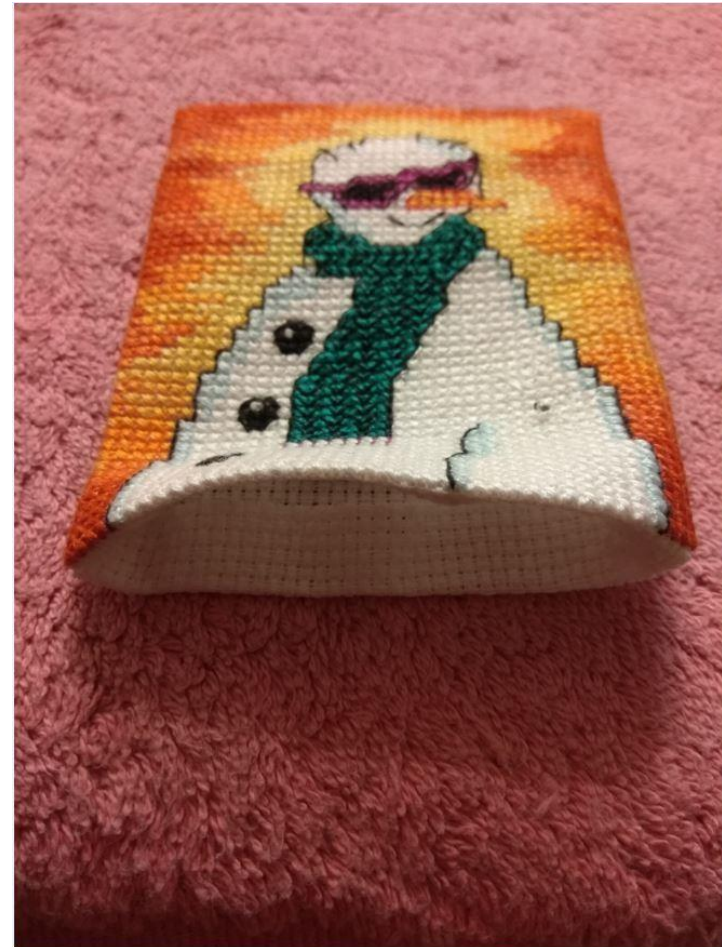
Step 6

Evert the item and iron the back side.



Step 7

Tuck the lower outsizes inward.



Step 8

Sew up an open area with the blind stitches.



Step 9

Iron the back side of the ready-made flag.





You may easily run the cord through the ready-made flag using the needle nr. 16 (for Stramin) with the blunt end.



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
